After a Power Outage...

It's that time of year when a power outage is more likely to occur. If your filter valve is a digital panel, here is what you need to know.

- To stop the screen from flashing, locate the screw to the right of the panel and unscrew to open cover
- Simply tap one of the buttons and you're good to go! The valve will keep its memory for a minimum of 48 hours – all master programming is held
- Note: the unit still works even though the screen is flashing
